What is the station status tool and what does it do?

The Station Status tool in WinSPC's Administrator window can be found under 'Tools' -->'Station Status'. It serves 2 purposes:

- 1) To list every station and corresponding station name that has ever logged into WinSPC.
- 2) Show the version of WinSPC each stations most recently used.

WinSPC requires that each station is on the same version of WinSPC on a given WinSPC database.

Therefore the Station Status window can serve as a way to keep track of which stations have logged in at any time since an upgrade.

You can use the Station Status as a way of tracking stations that may have been decommissioned or taken offline within your organization.

NOTE: If you are using Terminal Services in User Mode, you might also be able to track who has logged in after an upgrade, as in this configuration WinSPC will use a user's Windows credentials as the station.
